on appointing a member of the Scientific Committee

THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE GLOBAL HEALTH EDCTP3 JOINT UNDERTAKING,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EU) No 2021/2085 of 19 November 2021 establishing the Joint Undertakings under Horizon Europe¹, in particular Article 21;

Having regard to Governing Board Decision N° GB 05/2022 on the selection process and criteria for the composition of the Scientific Committee;

Having regard to the outcome of the selection process presented by the chairperson of the Governing Board on 28 February 2022 (ARES(2022)1471840);

Having regard to Governing Board Decision N° GB 06/2022 appointment of the members of the Scientific Committee and the establishment of a reserve list;

Having regard to Governing Board Decision N° GB 06/2023 appointing two additional members of the Scientific Committee;

Whereas:

One of the two members appointed by the most recent decision of the Governing Board to fill two vacant seats (06/2023) chose not to join the scientific committee (ARES(2023)4790646);

It is appropriate to replace this individual with an expert covering similar subject-matters, while keeping a balanced representation of genders, nationalities and countries where the experts are based;

The reserve list established by the Governing Board includes an expert with an adequate profile;
